

> For over a year, we have faced one storm and trial after another. Yet we are here. Thanking God for life, and drawing hope and strength from Christ Jesus.


> Last year, we spent Holy Week at home during a lockdown.


Why should you (ALMOST CERTAINLY) attend The Back Porch service?


