

This last weekend, we enjoyed a wonderful Saturday afternoon of worship at The Back Porch and great fellowship at the Crawfish Boil.


Our children are signing up and adults are preparing for Vacation Bible School!

# from the associate rector...

The Rev. Dr. Matt Boulter / Associate Rector

In 2011 long before anyone had ever heard of "COVID-19" or the "Coronavirus," about 75 folks (plus lots of kiddos) gathered on a Saturday night at the Boulter home (named by Bouquet as "the Hollows") for the first annual Christ Church Crawfish Boil. Planned as a way to

build community and foster fellowship within and around the Epiphany Community (a new worship service launched on the 4th floor of the Grelling-Spence Building in downtown Tyler), it was truly a smashing success. Many, many young couples as well as single folks said, "We didn't know that church or Christian community could be like this."

True, it was loads of fun. It was also lots of work! I vividly remember scrubbing down coolers and pots on Sunday morning (three or four years in a row), right before "booking it" to the church to perform Sunday services! Hence, Mrs. Boulter was grateful indeed when the location of the annual event was moved to the verdant fields of Christ Church South (and, hence, so was her husband)!




