



Keeping the Flame Alive (at Christ Church South)

In our beautiful sanctuary at Christ Church Downtown, right above the aumbry, there is a candle. I suppose it's called the "aumbry candle." It symbolizes the presence of Jesus Christ, whose Body, in the form of consecrated, eucharistic bread, resides in the aumbry itself. That candle is a vivid reminder of "Emmanuel," that God is with us, always.

Now, we don't have an aumbry candle (or even an aumbry) at Christ Church South. And yet in my opinion this is nevertheless an apt image for how things have been at Christ Church South during the Coronavirus Pandemic of 2020–21.

For, during the pandemic, and thanks to a small army of sacrificial "volunteer saints," we have kept the flame alive at Christ Church South. The flame of God's love in Christ. The flame of the Gospel. The flame of Christian hope.

Truly, for much or most of the pandemic we at Christ Church South have been doing triple duty with a skeleton crew. Two years ago, there was one service of Holy Eucharist at Christ Church South. For much of the pandemic, we have had *three*: in addition to the 11:05 service, we had the 9:00 and the Saturday Night Back Porch Service. Each service required hosts, altar guild, audio-visual staff, and musicians.

And when you add on top of all that, the tricky business of live-streaming those services (together with some of the Christian formation classes)—and things got *especially* tricky in the wake of the "2021 polar vortex" which wreaked havoc on our Christ Church South facilities—this meant that we were bearing a heavy load indeed. All in the midst of a virus which, with good reason, tended to freak many people out (if I might put it like that).

The devil wants to divide us (that's literally what *diabolos* means in Greek), but "greater is he who is in us than he who is in the world."

But who is "us"? Who is "we"? Who are the people who bore this load, who sacrificed to keep the Gospel flame of love alive? Too many to name, they are the courageous, sacrificial leaders who served as hosts, as altar guild members, as audio-visual tech team members, as "stream-team" folks (who got countless videos uploaded YouTube and Facebook), and as our wonderful Christ Church South musicians. The leaders of these teams (and the folks who deserve honorable mention) include: Laura Zeiher (host teams), Linda Watson and Nancy McReynolds and Samantha Hague (altar guild), Paul Squyres and Justin Mayes (audio visuals & stream team), and Robert Finney (music). Other names I cannot *not* mention are Tim Quinn, our valiant & tireless Christ Church South Junior Warden, and Gabe Clayton and Lindzay Boone, who led music at the Saturday Night Back Porch Service on multiple occasions, Patrick Willis who hosted on Saturday afternoons, and Anthony Moore, our wonderful Christ Church South sexton. (Thanks be to God for our nursery workers, overseen by Tina McGee!)

Thanks to these folks (who will be recognized this Sunday at a 10AM reception at Christ Church South with coffee & goodies), Christ Church South is poised to spring back into action in a post-pandemic season (God willing)!

For them, and many more, I am profoundly thankful. Thanks be to God!


