In you Lord is our hope...

Last Sunday I served at Christ Church South, and on my way to the church, I stopped at Fresh to get gas for my truck. I was in for a shock. My pickup is a diesel, and when I finished filling the tank, the total was \$125. The price per gallon was \$4.93. This really got my attention. Six months ago, I remember paying \$2.75 per gallon at the new Murphy's on the corner of Front and Beckham Streets. This inflation is getting personal, but the high price of diesel fuel is not going to affect only me. Our entire transportation system runs on diesel - the trucking industry, railroads, ships, and airplanes.

Of course, inflation is not our only concern. We still have Covid, war in the Ukraine, immigration, abortion, baby formula, division and acrimony in our country, mass shootings and on and on. As we look at the world around us, it is hard to see where all of this is going. Where do we find hope for the future? Well, I don't think we can place our hope in Washington, D.C. I noticed yesterday in the midst of all of these problems demanding a resolution, our House of Representatives was holding hearings on UFOs.

In our Morning Prayer, Rite II, we pray in Suffrages B, Lord, show us your love and mercy, for we put our trust in you. In you, Lord, is our hope; and we shall never hope in vain. Our hope as Christians is this: at some point in time, Jesus will come again, and history will come to an end. All of the problems, I mentioned will be no more. Recently, as I planned for a funeral, the family of the deceased chose a reading that gives us a beautiful picture of our hope in our Lord.

Revelation 21:2-7

And I saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband. And I heard a loud voice from the throne saying, "Behold, the dwelling place of God is with man. He will dwell with them, and they will be his people, and God himself will be with them as their God. He will wipe away every tear from their eyes, and death shall be no more, neither shall there be mourning, nor crying, nor pain anymore, for the former things have passed away."

As Christians, we can remain positive because we have real hope, our hope comes from the Lord, the maker of heaven and earth. I next time I fill up my truck with diesel fuel, I will try to remember that.


FROM BACH TO BROADWAY ON BOIS D'ARC






