From the Rector:

In the sixth month the angel Gabriel was sent by God to a town in Galilee called Nazareth, to a virgin engaged to a man whose name was Joseph, of the house of David. The virgin's name was Mary. And he came to her and said, "Greetings, favored one! The Lord is with you." Luke 1.26-29

I have been to Mary's house in Nazareth. It is quite small, smaller than most living rooms.

Dirt floor. Mud walls. Extremely humble.

We do not know how many siblings Mary had, but there was not much personal space in their home. So privacy was negligible to non-existent for her.

Mary was likely very young. Teenager-young. Perhaps early-teenager young.

Which makes her selection by the Creator of the Universe all the more remarkable.

God could have chosen a princess, but He chose Mary. The Lord could have chosen an adult, a National Merit finalist, Miss Universe, but He chose Mary.

God chose to enter into the world through a young teenage girl living in a very modest home in a very small town in a minor part of the Roman Empire.

Mary's response to Gabriel is, perhaps, the greatest statement of faith in the Bible.

"My soul magnifies the Lord, and my spirit rejoices in God my Savior, for he has looked on the humble estate of his servant. For behold, from now on all generations will call me blessed; for he who is mighty has done great things for me, and holy is his name." Luke 1.46-49

As you celebrate Thanksgiving and begin the walk through Advent, remember that God has chosen you. He has chosen to love you. He has chosen to bless you. He has chosen to save you.

The Lord has called you to a great task—to know Christ. I pray that this Advent, the Lord will do great things in your life. Preparing you—as never before—to celebrate the birth and life of Jesus Christ.




