#### FROM THE RECTOR:

"Make a joyful noise to the Lord, all the earth; break forth into joyous song and sing praises!" Psalm 98.4

(Jesus said), "These things I have spoken to you, that my joy may be in you, and that your joy may be full." John 15.11

Many things give us pleasure. I love the feeling of a heavy wind on my face, the smile of a baby on Sunday morning.

Anuschka Rees writes that pleasure is an immediate, positive sensation. All manner of things bring us pleasure: laughing at a joke, eating chocolate, reflecting on a good memory, watching a good comedy, swimming in the ocean, listening to music. Pleasure can come from anything that feels good in that exact moment.

Pleasure is a temporary emotion. It's usually a reaction to external factors. Most of the time, pleasure is a reaction, not a choice.

Joy is different.

'Joy' is described and commended in the Bible hundreds of times. Joy is a state of being inside of us, characterized by contentment and satisfaction.



How do we nurture Christian joy in the midst of hardship or pain? In Philippians 4.4, the Apostle Paul gives us the key: "Rejoice in the Lord always". In Can I have Joy In My Life, RC Sproul writes that "the key to the Christian's joy is its source, which is the Lord. The Christian is always in the Lord and the Lord is always in the Christian, and that is always a reason for joy. Even if the Christian cannot rejoice in the circumstances, if he finds himself passing through pain, sorrow, or grief, he still can rejoice in Christ."

I pray that as the days grow shorter and leaves begin to fall, the Lord will fill your heart with joy—the joy of the Lord Jesus Christ!

#### Goodbye for Six Months

Next Saturday, Ann and I will be packing up for our trip to Jupiter Island, Florida where I begin my fourth year as associate chaplain at Christ Memorial Chapel. This call to ministry there began when I received a call literally "out of the blue" from a woman I had known when she was a student at Nashotah House Seminary, and I was associate dean. The Very Rev. Heidi Kinner had just been named chaplain at the Chapel and offered me the chance to be her associate. Fr. David graciously allowed me to accept the position and also to continue ministry at Christ Church, Tyler. So, God willing, I will be back at Christ Church in May.



Christ Memorial Chapel was completed in 1939, Mr. and Mrs. William Barstow's gift to the island in memory of Mrs. Bartow's sister, Laura Fontenay Delespine Duclos. It was the Barstow's thought that this would be the island church; and that, while under the canons of the Episcopal diocese, it would always welcome members of every denomination, residents, and guests, to

form a center for worship and fellowship: A House of Prayer for All People. It is a seasonal chapel open from the first Sunday in November until the last Sunday in April.

There are about 400 members in the Chapel, and the membership is very ecumenical. There are a number of

traditional Episcopalians, but there are also many denominations found in the membership. The Chapel is on the seventh tee of the Jupiter Island Club golf course.

There are two services on Sunday mornings - 8:30 and 11:00. It is strange standing on the steps of the Chapel waiting to process in to begin the service while there are golfers teeing off right behind us. Like in the old days in the Diocese of Texas, there is Holy Eucharist only once a month with Morning Prayer on the other Sundays at the 11:00 service. There is Eucharist every Sunday at 8:30. The attendance is very good with a full chapel at both services.

There is no Sunday School, but there are five Bible studies during the week. Heidi leads three of them, and I have a men's and a women's Bible study on Wednesday mornings. Last year I led a study of Isaiah, and this year the study will be on the Letter to the Hebrews. Attendance at the studies is pretty good, considering the competition from golf programs.

At my age the call to ministry at Christ Memorial Chapel was a surprise but has been a pleasant and productive one. We enjoy our time in Florida, but I consider Christ Church, Tyler our home. Psalm 26 says Lord, I love the house in which you dwell and the place where your glory abides. And I love the people who dwell in that house.






