#### FROM THE RECTOR:

Isaiah 58.10: 'If you pour yourself out for the hungry and satisfy the desire of the afflicted, then shall your light rise in the darkness and your gloom be as the noonday'

Matthew 25.37-40: (Jesus continued), 'Then the righteous will answer him, saying, 'Lord, when did we see you hungry and feed you, or thirsty and give you drink?' . . . And the King will answer them, 'Truly, I say to you, as you did it to one of the least of these my brothers, you did it to me.'


The Bible has a lot to say about feeding the hungry.

I have always been especially convicted by the teaching of *James 2.14-18*. James writes to the Church, 'What good is it, my brothers and sisters, if someone says he has faith but does not have works?

Can that faith save him? If a brother or sister is poorly clothed and lacking in daily food, and one of you says to them, "Go in peace, be warmed and filled," without giving them the things needed for the body, what good is that? So also faith by itself, if it does not have works, is dead... I will show you my faith by my works.'

Reasonable and faithful people can debate the role of government programs in feeding the hungry. Yet the obligation for faithful Christians to feed people that are hungry in not debatable.

This past Sunday, many scores of Christ Church families, responding to the urgent need to provide food for East Texas families impacted by the failure of our government leaders to provide expected food through the SNAP or



food stamp program, filled both Christ Church campuses with bags of groceries and made generous donations to the East Texas Food Bank. Thank you for your generosity!

Over the past 48 hours, Christ Church has delivered hundreds of pounds of food to local pantries which are experiencing long lines of hungry people. Thank you for your compassion!

God willing, our elected officials will renew funding for the SNAP program in the coming days. Until they do, Christ Church will continue to collect groceries every Sunday, revealing our love for Jesus and for our neighbors.

# from the associate rector... **The Rev. Dr. Cole Hartin**Associate Rector



As I've been working through the book of Isaiah in our adult Christian formation, I came across verses 40:6-8 once again. These verses are poignant for me:

All flesh is grass;

their constancy is like the flower of the field.

The grass withers; the flower fades, when the breath of the Lord blows upon it; surely the people are grass.

The grass withers; the flower fades, but the word of our God will stand forever.

I think these verses point to a truth of created life that rings especially true in the fall. All of human life is fading away like grass, or flowers... or the leaves falling from our trees. They appear for a while, and then they are gone. If I translated this passage into an East Texan dialect, it might read a little different, but not too much:

All flesh is the leaves from a catalpa tree;
the leaves yellow, fall, and blow away
when the breath of the Lord blows upon them
with the autumn wind.
The leaves crumple and scatter
but the word of the Lord endures.

This is how I would put it, or something like this, anyways. The falling leaves outside my living room window remind me that another season has passed, that the verdant greens of spring and bustling life of summer inevitably lead to the decay and death at fall time.

Our lives are no different. They too start to flag as we head into the autumn time of life.

This truth is cause for some sadness, but it is sweet sadness. There is beauty in the fall season because it is so fleeting, and the transitory nature of our lives is part of what lends to them their meaning.

And behind all of the seasons of the year and of our lives stands the Word of the Lord. God spoke creation into being by his Word, and this

Word became flesh and dwelt among us. We still commune with this Word as we hear him speak to us in Holy Scripture and are nurtured by him in the Eucharist.

Our lives may be fading like the year, but our connection to Jesus is stabilizing, a reminder that God is present through it all. There is a lovely prayer in the service of Compline that asks God for his protection through the night "so that we who are wearied by the changes and chances of this fleeting world, may repose upon [God's] eternal changelessness." May God protect us this autumn, with all the uncertainty and beauty it brings, so that we mind find rest even in our weariness.




